### FORMER MEMBERS OF LADIES CHOICE FITNESS-GREENVILLE

**Columbia, SC.....**If you are a former member of *Ladies Choice Fitness Center, 490 S. Pleasantburg Road, Greenville, SC, 29607*, please be advised of the following: Consumers who joined Ladies Choice and signed an agreement for either an installment or pre-paid membership may cancel their contracts, if they do not wish to attend alternate facilities offered by Ladies Choice.

**You are not required to, but may at your option** attend an alternate facility offered by your former gym for which you did not sign an agreement. Should you choose not to attend an alternate facility, a cancellation notice should be directed immediately to the address listed in the "right to cancel" provisions of your contract. In addition, if your contract has an automatic draft provision your financial institution should be notified to stop the draft. Consumers who paid in full should request a pro-rate refund directly from Ladies Choice.
