CONSUMER AFFAIRS TO OPEN BOILING SPRINGS AND LANDRUM OFFICES

Columbia, SC..... The South Carolina Department of Consumer Affairs will open two new satellite locations at the Boiling Springs Public Library and the Landrum Public Library on September 19.

The Department will make quarterly visits to the satellite locations. Additionally, SCDCA Outreach Coordinator Patty Guthrie will serve the Boiling Springs and Landrum areas and be available to consumers via phone, e-mail, or appointment by request Monday through Friday. Guthrie is excited about being able to service a wider area of the Upstate and providing consumers face-to-face feedback and attention. “Having a satellite office in the area not only provides consumers face-to-face access with staff, but it also allows the Department to tailor workshops and education initiatives to address the issues Upstate consumers deal with most,” said Guthrie.

The Boiling Springs and Landrum satellite openings are the result of a collaborative effort with librarians Jean Foster and Lee Morgan, respectively. The Department currently has satellite offices in Gaffney, Laurens, and Summerville with regularly scheduled visits to all locations.
