Senate Bill 810 amended the South Carolina Pawnbrokers Act to require pawnbrokers to electronically transfer records of all pledged items to a database approved by the Department of Consumer Affairs ("SCDCA") that will be accessible by law enforcement. The new law becomes effective August 15, 2018.

After researching available databases, SCDCA has determined there are two viable options for South Carolina pawnbrokers: LeadsOnline and Business Watch International's New RAPID software. If the pawnshop is located in a jurisdiction where a local ordinance or law requires the use of an electronic system, the pawnshop must use the SCDCA-approved database chosen by that county or municipality. If there is no local ordinance or law, the pawnshop must choose one of the two SCDCA-approved databases. You can contact the vendors for the approved databases as follows:

All pawnbrokers must notify SCDCA in writing **no later than August 27, 2018**, which database the pawnbroker is using or intends to use. Written notice can be emailed to Legal@scconsumer.gov or mailed to SCDCA, Attn: Pawnbrokers, P.O. Box 5757, Columbia, S.C. 29250-5757.

All pawn transactions occurring on or after August 15, 2018, must be logged into one of the two databases. If a pawnbroker is unable to have its database up and running by this date, it must subsequently enter all pawn transactions occurring on or after August 15<sup>th</sup> into its database once functional. However, this shall occur **no later** than September 6, 2018.
