Consumers may come with questions or complaints regarding a business between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Individuals are encouraged to bring documentation with them.

Mr. Crofoot will also have additional materials available explaining the limitations of debt collectors and how to avoid deceptive practices. With consumer debt being at an all time high, debt collectors are targeting more and more consumers across the country. South Carolina is no exception. "Month after month, year after year, debt collection ranks in the top three types of complaints that the Department receives," said Donna DeMichael, SCDCA Director of Consumer Services.

The Department will continue to visit the Greenwood community on a regular basis. Locations will be announced monthly. The Department services the entire state via telephone and online help.
